1. Introduction

Welcome to ConceptRadar.

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the ConceptRadar platform ("Platform").

By using the Platform, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, you must not use the Platform.

2. Definitions

For these Terms of Use, the following definitions apply:

Platform: the ConceptRadar web application and any related services made available by ConceptRadar.

User: any individual or organisation accessing or using the Platform.

Content: ideas, documents, links, text, and any other material submitted by users.

AI Outputs: summaries, classifications, scores, recommendations, and other outputs generated by the Platform through artificial intelligence.

3. About ConceptRadar

ConceptRadar is an AI-assisted knowledge intelligence platform designed to help users discover, organise, analyse, and explore knowledge. The user can also add sources through links, documents or sandbox ideas.

The Platform enables users to:

- discover concepts from publicly available sources;
- analyse scientific and technical knowledge;
- submit their own ideas through the Idea Sandbox;
- explore relationships between concepts;
- interact with AI-assisted knowledge visualisations and analysis.

ConceptRadar is intended to support research, exploration, and knowledge discovery. It does not provide scientific, legal, medical, financial, or other professional advice. Users remain responsible for independently evaluating information before relying on information or AI-generated outputs provided by the Platform.

ConceptRadar is continuously evolving. Features may be added, modified, improved or removed as part of the ongoing development of the Platform.

4. Eligibility

You may use the Platform only if you:

- are legally capable of entering into a binding agreement;
- comply with these Terms;
- comply with all applicable laws while using the Platform.

5. User Accounts

No user accounts are provided.

6. Acceptable Use

You agree not to:

- violate applicable laws;
- upload malicious software or harmful code;
- interfere with the security or operation of the Platform;
- attempt to gain unauthorised access to systems, accounts, or data;
- misuse AI functionality through automated abuse or manipulation;

- upload content that infringes intellectual property rights;
- intentionally submit misleading, fraudulent, or unlawful content.
- use automated tools to scrape, extract, or systematically reproduce substantial portions of the Platform or its underlying knowledge graph, except where expressly permitted by applicable law or with ConceptRadar's prior written permission.

ConceptRadar may suspend or restrict access where reasonably necessary to protect the Platform, its users, or applicable legal obligations.

7. Idea Submission

The Idea Sandbox allows users to privately develop and analyse their own ideas before deciding whether to publish them.

Unless you choose to publish your ideas, submissions remain privately processed in the browser. You remain responsible for all content that you submit.

8. Ownership of User Content

You retain ownership of the ideas, documents, and other content you submit to ConceptRadar.

To operate the Platform, you grant ConceptRadar a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free licence to:

- store your submissions;
- process them using AI;
- analyse and classify them;
- generate visualisations and recommendations;
- display them according to your chosen privacy settings.

This licence exists solely for operating, maintaining, securing, and improving the Platform and providing its functionality to users.

ConceptRadar does not acquire ownership of your ideas.

9. Publication of Ideas

Where the Platform allows publication of user ideas:

- Publication is always initiated by the user;
- Users remain the owners of their published work;
- Users are responsible for ensuring they have the right to publish submitted material.

Published content may remain publicly available until removed by ConceptRadar in accordance with these Terms. ConceptRadar may remove published content where reasonably necessary to:

- comply with legal obligations;
- protect intellectual property rights;
- prevent abuse;
- protect the security or integrity of the Platform.

10. Artificial Intelligence

ConceptRadar uses artificial intelligence to assist with analysing information, identifying relationships, generating summaries, and assigning knowledge scores.

AI-generated outputs:

- are generated automatically;
- are intended to support research and exploration;
- may contain inaccuracies, omissions, or outdated information.

ConceptRadar does not guarantee that AI-generated analyses, classifications, or scores are complete, accurate, or suitable for any particular purpose.

Users remain responsible for evaluating AI-generated outputs before relying on them.

11. Platform Scores and Classifications

ConceptRadar may assign AI-assisted scores, classifications, and other analytical outputs to concepts and knowledge contained within the Platform.

These assessments are intended solely to support research, exploration, and knowledge discovery.

Unless explicitly stated otherwise, platform-generated scores, classifications, and rankings:

- are algorithmic assessments;
- are not objective measurements of quality or correctness;
- may evolve as methodologies improve or additional information becomes available.

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how ConceptRadar ("we", "our", or "us") processes personal data when you use the platform.

ConceptRadar is committed to protecting your privacy and processing personal data in accordance with applicable data protection laws, including the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP).

3. Personal Data

ConceptRadar does not collect personal data except:

- IP address is stored for 24 h as a security measure
- ConceptRadar stores user-provided information only if a sandbox idea is chosen to be mapped on the radar using the option to specifically include user information. The user can check ideas privately or post them anonymously on ConceptRadar.

4. Personal Data Processing

ConceptRadar does not process personal data in any way and does not sell personal data.

5. Legal Basis

Where the GDPR applies, ConceptRadar follows the following legal bases:

6. AI Processing

ConceptRadar uses AI technologies based in different countries (including but not limited to US and China) to analyse scientific concepts, research or user-submitted ideas, and publicly available knowledge.

AI-generated analyses, summaries, classifications, and scores are produced automatically and should not be interpreted as objective facts or professional advice. Please note: any data provided, including personal data submitted with sandbox ideas, might be used to train future AI models.

7. Sharing of Personal Data

The sandbox idea is associated with personal data and it is fully user controlled. If the user decides to share its chosen personal data, it is publicly available on the platform and may be shared also with service providers necessary to operate the platform.

The IP address of the user is stored for 24 hours for security measures. It may be shared with service providers, including but not limited to the current providers:

- Google Cloud
- Dynamic selection of different AI models based around the globe including but not limited to models from the United States of America and China.

8. International Data Transfers

Service providers process data outside Switzerland or the European Economic Area.

9. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary to provide the service or comply with legal obligations.

The IP is stored for 24 hours.

10. Your Rights

Where applicable, you have the right to:

- access your personal data;
- correct inaccurate data;
- request deletion;
- request restriction of processing;
- object to certain processing;
- receive a copy of your data where applicable.

ConceptRadar AI Governance Policy

1. Purpose

This Policy describes how artificial intelligence ("AI") is used within ConceptRadar and establishes the basic governance principles for its use.

It applies to all AI functionality provided through the Platform.

2. Use of AI

ConceptRadar uses AI to support knowledge discovery and analysis.

Depending on the functionality available, AI may be used to:

- analyse information;
- extract concepts;
- classify knowledge;
- identify relationships;

- generate summaries;
- assist with concept scoring;
- support user interaction with the Platform.

AI is intended to support users and does not replace human judgment.

3. AI Outputs

AI-generated outputs are produced automatically and may contain inaccuracies, omissions or outdated information.

ConceptRadar does not guarantee the completeness or accuracy of AI-generated outputs.

Users should independently evaluate AI-generated information before relying on it.

4. Platform Scores

ConceptRadar may generate analytical scores relating to concepts.

These scores are algorithmic assessments intended to support exploration and comparison.

They are not objective measurements and may change as methodologies or available information evolve.

5. Human Oversight

ConceptRadar does not treat AI-generated outputs as authoritative facts.

Users remain responsible for their own decisions and for evaluating information obtained through the Platform.

Please note: there is no human oversight of this Platform. The HITL concept was intentionally replaced by the model-in-the-loop (MITL) and diverse model-in-the-loop (dMITL) concepts to provide a fully autonomous Platform.

It is the sole responsibility of the user to evaluate the AI-generated output before relying on it.

6. Data Protection

AI functionality shall be implemented in accordance with the ConceptRadar Privacy Policy and applicable data protection laws.
